PLACES TO VISIT



Kamakhya temple is a famous pilgrimage located on the Nilachal hill, Guwahati at about 17 km distance from the venue



Kalakshetra is a cultural institute situated in Panjabari, Guwahati, Assam. It includes cultural museum, library & it is near the venue



Kaziranga national park area is 429.93 sq km. It is inhabited by the world largest one horned rhinoceroses. The distance from Guwahati city is 169 km.



Assam state museum is located in southern end of Dighali pukhuri tank, 10.7 km away from the venue



Umananda Island is the smallest river island in the midst of river Brahmaputra flowing through the city of Guwahati in Assam, a state in North East India.



Shillong is the capital of Meghalaya, being a hill town, also famous tourist hub of northeast India. The city is known as the Scotland of East. The distance is 99 km by road from Guwahati
